### City of Lake Charles Proposition No. 1 of 3 (Millage Renewal)

Shall the City of Lake Charles, Louisiana (the "City") continue to levy and collect a tax not to exceed 2.31 mills in any year on all property subject to taxation within the City for a period of ten (10) years beginning with the year 2027, with collections from the levy of the tax estimated to be \$1,470,122 for one entire year, for maintenance of public buildings, streets and bridges in the City?
