Consolidated Gravity Drainage District No. 2A Proposition (Millage)

Shall Consolidated Gravity Drainage District No. 2A of the Parish of St. Mary, State of Louisiana (the "District") be authorized to levy a tax of seven and thirty-hundredths (7.30) mills (the estimated amount reasonably expected to be collected from the levy of the tax for one entire year being \$1,300,000) on all the property subject to taxation in the District for a period of ten (10) years, beginning with the year 2021 and ending with the year 2030, for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, maintaining and operating gravity and forced drainage works and other flood protection improvements within and for the District?
