Consolidated Sewerage District No. 1 Proposition (Sewer Millage)

Shall Consolidated Sewerage District No. 1 of the Parish of Jefferson, State of Louisiana (the "District") be authorized to levy and collect a tax of not to exceed five (5.0) mills on all property subject to taxation in the District for a period of ten (10) years, beginning with the year 2023, with the estimated amount reasonably expected to be collected from the levy of the tax for one year being \$15,230,872, for the purposes of acquiring, constructing, improving, maintaining and/or operating sewerage works and facilities within and for the District?
