Fire District No. Six Proposition No. 1 of 2 (Millage Continuation)  Shall Caddo Parish Fire District No. Six, State of Louisiana (the "District"), continue to levy a special tax of ten and sixteen hundredths (10.16) mills on all property subject to taxation in the District (an estimated \$490,000 reasonably expected at this time to be collected from the levy of the tax for an entire year), for a period of ten (10) years, beginning with the year 2024 and ending with the year 2033, for the purpose of fire protection, all emergency service incidental thereto, maintenance and operational expenses, said millage to represent a sixteen hundredths of a mill (.16) increase (due to reappraisal) over the 10 mills tax authorized to be levied through the year 2023 pursuant to an election held on May 3, 2014? Fire District No. Six Proposition No. 2 of 2 (Service Charge Renewal)
Shall Caddo Parish Fire District No. Six, State of Louisiana (the "District"), continue to levy and collect a service charge of \$75.00 per year for a period of 10 years, on each residential dwelling and commercial structure, whether occupied or unoccupied, located wholly or partly within the boundaries of the District, beginning with the year 2024 and ending with the year 2033 (an estimated \$216,375 reasonably expected at this time to be collected from the levy of the
